



## Cheshire Neighbourhood Watch Association (CNWA) Committee Member – Halton Area Election Process

In line with the CNWA constitution, the following guidelines for the election of Committee Members have been agreed by the current CNWA committee.

### Nomination

Any Neighbourhood Watch Co-ordinator from the Cheshire West area is eligible to self-nominate for a CNWA committee position. Only Scheme Co-ordinators are eligible to stand for election.

Nominations must be accompanied by two references from either a current scheme member, or a colleague from an organisation you have been involved with, or from an organisation you have worked for.

Nominations with supporting reference forms must be submitted by **midnight Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> May 2018** to: Secretary, CNWA, c/o Volunteers Office, Cheshire Constabulary, Chester Way, Northwich, Cheshire CW9 5EP or email [Volunteer.WatchAlert@cheshire.pnn.police.uk](mailto:Volunteer.WatchAlert@cheshire.pnn.police.uk) .

### Voting Process

The voting membership shall consist of any registered Neighbourhood Watch Co-ordinator from the Halton area.

If there are two or less nominees, the nominee(s) will be invited to join the committee. Members will be advised of the outcome by **Thursday 31<sup>st</sup> May 2018**.

If there are three or more nominees, a members' meeting will be arranged in the **Halton area**, at which candidates will be chosen using a show of hands by other Neighbourhood Watch Co-ordinators from the Halton area. A list of nominees will be sent via email, prior to the meeting, which will be held in **June**. The results will be announced to the membership within three days of the meeting.

Independent adjudication will be via a Cheshire Partner Agency.
